Dear Mr. Bishop:

We wish to thank you for visiting with us on June 12, 1980, to discuss our press release of February 1, 1980, about discontinuation of supply of Du Pont's Teflon® fluorocarbon resins or untrademarked fluorocarbon micropowder for use as ingredients of oil additives for lubricating internal combustion engines.

According to the information presented by you, the fluorocarbon product you purchased from Du Pont was a component but not the primary active lubricative agent in the "Petrolon" formulation. As such, it appears that the "Petrolon" formula with its special combination of ingredients, which was not dependent upon Du Pont's product as the active agent, falls outside our press release. That, you will recall, pertains solely to the use of Du Pont fluorocarbon resins or micropowders as the active lubricative agent.

As we discussed, since you are no longer going to be purchasing fluorocarbon micropowders from Du Pont, we must ask that you do not make any reference to our trademark on your containers and in your advertising and promotional materials.
